The next step in the development of the project "**SEEDS: Substance of circular Economy concept as Efficacious Determinant for the development of Successful entrepreneurship**" focuses on the development of the *SEEDS Recognition and validation Open Education Resource (OER)*, aimed to be applied in the area of recognition and validation of competences acquired through the participation in non-formal training courses on Circular Economy related aspects and their implementation in day to day activities of startupper.

In parallel, the partners are also working to translate the *SEEDS m-learning solution for startupper* in their languages and create video and audio files to accompany the training modules to make them more appealing to VET users and entrepreneurs.

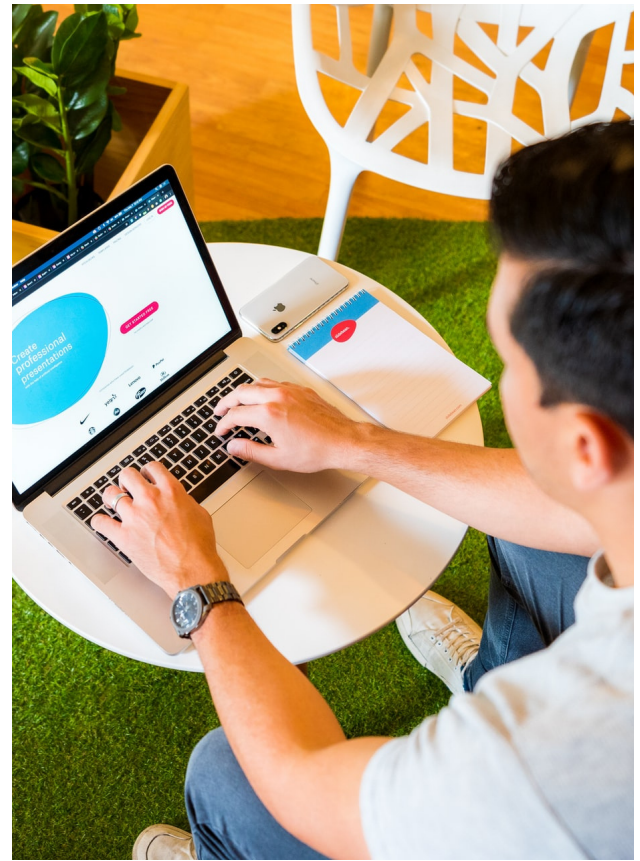

PROJECT RESULTS

The six modules of the first Intellectual Output of the project, "**SEEDS m-learning solution for startups**" in English are ready and will soon be implemented on the mobile-friendly web based platform. The outcome includes training materials for the following areas, structured in six modules:

- Use waste as a resource, by BEST (Austria);
- The reuse of water from wastewater treatment plants, by Universitat Rovira i Virgili (Spain)
- Design for the future, by Quarter Mediation (Netherlands);
- Rethink the business model for sustainable development, by CWEP (Poland);
- Incorporate digital technology for sustainable development, by LABC (Italy);
- Effective and sustainable product labeling, by LUDOR (Romania).



PROJECT ACTIVITIES

On 4th and 5th of October 2021, Universitat Rovira i Virgili organised in Barcelona, Spain, a hybrid transnational project meeting.
